

The Hughes Trailer NRSHA Collegiate National Championship Show
Texas Tech Equestrian Center – Lubbock, Texas

Sunday & Monday, March 29-30, 2020

Format:

2 complete days of competition – each rider will show all 4 classes (cow, rein, ranch riding, ranch trail) on Sunday and again on Monday. Placings and standings will be posted after the first day. The team with the most points combined after both days is the champion team. The individuals with the most points combined on both days are the champion individuals of each division (Open/Non Pro, Limited, Novice)

There will be a two arena format, with one judge in each arena. Two classes will run in the indoor Kris Wilson Fearless Champion Arena. Two classes will run in one of the outdoor arenas, weather permitting. Judges will switch arenas for the second day.

Awards will be presented at an Awards Dinner on Monday evening. Tickets are included with entry fee. Additional tickets for families and students not riding can be purchased.

Division I Team: 4-6 riders (2 Non Pro, 2 Limited, 2 Novice)

Division II Team: 3-4 riders (any combination of 3-4 riders in the Limited & Novice divisions)

Only 1 Team per school, however an unlimited number of riders from each school can enter. Coaches must declare their point riders before the show starts each day. Point riders can be changed for the 2nd go-round as long as those changes are made before the start of the 2nd go-round. Any collegiate rider meeting eligibility requirements can enter. Schools are not required to have a team. All riders are eligible for individual division awards.

Entry Fee:

\$255 per rider, includes the entry fee for 2 go-rounds, office fee, cattle fee for both go-rounds and awards dinner

Additional Awards Dinner tickets available for \$15

Stalls \$25/night; Shavings \$10/bag; RVs \$25/night (No outside shavings please)

No membership fees

No competition licenses

Entries are due in the office by Monday, March 16th. Late entries are accepted with a \$25 late fee per entry.

Awards:

Division I and Division II Champion Teams – the use of a Hughes Trailer for one year, with the option to purchase at the end of the year, or bring back to the 2021 NRSHA Collegiate Championship

Division I and Division II Reserve Champion Teams – CowTrac Mechanical Cow

Buckles for Champion and Reserve individuals in 3 divisions (Non Pro, Limited, Novice)

Jackets for the Top 5 individuals in 3 divisions

Prize packages for Top 10 individuals in 3 divisions

Other Details:

There will be a brief Coaches Meeting on Saturday evening, March 28. At that time coaches will turn in their point riders. We are also planning an event for all students on Saturday evening.

We are planning a short Saturday evening activity with school introductions, etc. Please make plans to arrive in Lubbock in time for that activity. More information will be provided as it gets closer.

Teams can arrive at the Texas Tech Equestrian Center on Friday, March 27 or Saturday, March 28. Evening or late night arrivals please contact the Equestrian Center during business hours to make arrangements for stalling, etc. There is an FFA Judging Contest on Saturday morning in the Indoor Arena, however multiple outdoor arenas will be available for riding Friday and Saturday. The Indoor Arena will be available Saturday afternoon as long as the facility is not preparing the dirt. Both indoor and outdoor arenas will be used for the competition, weather permitting.

Hotel Rooms:

There are 2 blocks of rooms under “NRSHA Collegiate Show” -- Holiday Inn for \$89/night (closest to the arenas). There is another block Arbor Inn & Suites also for \$89, and they are nearby as well.
