## MAISEN AVENT CROWNED ALL-AROUND CHAMPION AT NATIONAL RANCH AND STOCK HORSE ALLIANCE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

*National Ranch and Stock Horse Alliance, Guthrie, Oklahoma* – Maisen Avent of Elbert, Colorado, captured the all-around Youth title at the National Ranch and Stock Horse Alliance National Championship Show held in conjunction with the AQHA Versatility Ranch Horse World Championships recently at the Lazy E Arena in Guthrie, Oklahoma.



After dominating the arena this past week, Maisen and Ellie May Rey left Guthrie with the youth all-around title. The pair finished 1<sup>st</sup> in cutting, 1<sup>st</sup> in cow work, 1<sup>st</sup> in reining, 1<sup>st</sup> in trail and 2<sup>nd</sup> in ranch riding. Maisen said her highlight of the week was how well Ellie May Rey worked in every class. In the fall Maisen plans to attend Tarleton State University, where she will continue to show on the Stock Horse Team.

Ellie May Rey is a 2015 mare by Rey Dual and out of Starlights Prize and was bred by the San Juan Ranch of

Weatherford, Texas.

The NRSHA all-around youth received a prize package that included a sterling-silver buckle, bronze trophy, champion neck ribbon, specially designed logoed jacket and champion patch.

Reserve champion honors went to Hickorys Stylish Cee a 2018 mare shown by Payton Porterfield of Brighton, Colorado.

More than 470 entries competed in NRSHA ranch trail, ranch reining, ranch riding, ranch cutting, ranch boxing and ranch cow work across 7 different divisions. Riders qualified for the National Championship Show by competing at three or more shows with one of the NRSHA partners.
